
1. Priority daycare placement for:

- a) Children whose placement is recommended by Social Services of the Youth Welfare Office (based on the fact of endangering the child's welfare according to §8a SGB VIII or promoting the child's welfare according to § 27 SGB VIII).
- b) Children who must attend school the following daycare year and are not attending any institutions yet.
- c) Children who already attend a nursery offer at the same institution at the transition time for kindergarten. The scope of care remains the same.

2. The following evaluation criteria apply to all children for childcare placement:

Objective legal entitlement criteria for daycare placement One 10 parent points employed* Both 20 Parents points employed* 22 One single points parent employed* * Employed means parents who pursue gainful employment or seek employment or attend a training program/ secondary education/ university education or receive benefits for integration in the labor market in the sense of SGB (Social Security Code) II.
