Mannheim model of child and young people participation

The participation model, which Mannheim's children and young people have developed, works like this. You have an idea about what might be better for children and young people in your neighborhood or somewhere else in Mannheim? You're dissatisfied with your current situation and would like things to change? Or you simply want to be asked occasionally?

There are different ways in which you can get your concerns to the politicians.

- Register with 68DEINS! – the bureau for children and young people in Mannheim and let us know your concerns. We can then have a look together at how we can proceed further.
- Come to one of our neighborhood meetings. Every year, meetings of children and young people take place in seven neighborhoods. If you want to know when and where the next one is, have a look [here](#) or register at the 68DEINS! bureau for children and young people.
- Take part in the citywide youth summit. Here you can discuss issues with other young people from age 14 from the entire city and then present them to politicians from Mannheim later on.
- Take part in the children's summit, which takes place every four years and is intended for children from age six.
